Bible Reading Schedule

Supernatural Lifestyle

When we accepted Jesus as our Savior and were born again, it was the Beginning of a New Life for us. As a matter of fact, the Bible calls it “Newness of Life” (*Rom. 6:4*). So, from that moment we entered a “Supernatural Lifestyle” ... The “Old Man” is dead and we are now New Creatures in Christ.

In the world’s eye, we are an oddity. The Word calls us “peculiar”, meaning we are all a “one off”. That term might be new to you... When a designer creates a single copy original, it’s a “one off”, not to be duplicated.

“But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light;” - 1 Pet. 2:9

We are born of the Seed of the Word. The Seed of Christ.

“Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.” -1 Pet. 1:23

“Incorruptible” being different from corruptible. Adam’s or natural man’s seed *is* corruptible, i.e. genetic declination. This is not so in Christ. Jesus called it being “born from above” (*John 3:3-6*) which means the Seed didn’t come from man.

- “The Word was made flesh” (*John 1:14*). That’s what happened to you. You were “born again” after an incorruptible seed, the Seed of God.
- Jesus is called “the first born among many brethren” (*Rom. 8:29*). We are the “many brethren”.

We don’t fit here. Although we will rule and reign here in our resurrected bodies, the “place” will change. Mankind *will* change, but “Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever” (*Heb. 13:8*). Such it is with us... You already are the New Man. Your “outer man” will be made conformable to the inner man in the Rapture/ Resurrection.
