Targeting Your Prayer

Jesus taught us in Mark 11 to use prayer as a means to deliver our faith to a specific purpose:

Mk 11:23 “For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.”

Mk 11:24 “Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.”

*We need to **Target** our Prayer to receive from God a complete restoration of our lives in 2021.

*Start by Naming all your personal needs & desires: then follow Jesus’ instruction to Pray & Receive specifically those things Named on your list... Maybe print it up, maybe put it on your fridge or personal bulletin board as a petition. Then as you pass it daily call it done like Jesus said, “when you pray believe that you receive it...”

-you receive it when you pray....

-then you call it done....

Other daily prayer topics:

I Tim 2:1-2 pray for all those in authority... (& all *men* everywhere)

“I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

² For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.”

Eph 6:18 pray for the saints (the Body of Christ)

“Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;”
