Passover is the name of the event where God granted a **Passover** to the nation of Israel while they were in bondage in Egypt.

Numerous plagues had come upon Egypt, decimating the land.

One final plague remained. It would weaken the entire nation of Egypt; a once proud nation would be brought to its knees. An entire generation, all of the firstborn of Egypt, would die overnight as death passed through the land.

The exception would be Israel – God's **covenant** people. God granted Israel a **Passover**.

With the marking of the blood of lambs on the lintels and doorposts, death would **Passover** the houses of the Israelites, leaving their firstborn untouched.

The New Testament, in 1 Corinthians 5, tells us that Jesus is our **Passover Lamb**.

For even Christ, our Passover is sacrificed for us. Therefore, let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. (1 Corinthians 5:7-8)

With the washing of His precious blood on our lives, our sins are remitted, and we are granted grace and mercy by Almighty God. We too are permitted to walk out of the camp with no effect of death on our lives.

You and I received a **Passover** when we accepted Jesus' sacrifice for ourselves.

God gave His own son as the **Sacrificial Lamb** for all of mankind.

We have since received repeated **Passovers** as God moves to separate us from the ravages of darkness that rage in our world.

The blood of Jesus is the marking. We are identified as God's when spiritual death 'comes calling.'

Every believer should be thankful for how God has provided a way of escape for His church.

God instructed the nation of Israel to have a memorial feast annually to commemorate that first **Passover**. They were to teach their children, and all succeeding generations, to be reminded of how God had mercy and provided a means of escape for all of them.

The entire event was to become a parallel message to us as well.

As the nation of Israel walked out of bondage the following morning, Jesus as our **Passover Lamb** was resurrected and walked out of hell for us.

He was raised from the dead and is **alive** today! Therefore, we are permitted to walk out on spiritual death.

The lamb the Israelites sacrificed was the best they had to offer. It was "without spot or blemish."

Jesus Christ, as our sinless lamb, paid for our salvation (release) with the giving of Himself.

We, in like manner, as a congregation, have brought our best to offer up in commemoration of His sacrifice.


Our offering is in the form of a monetary gift. We bring our **best** to offer in honor of Him.
