Bible Reading Schedule

“Locked & Loaded”

As Jesus trained those around Him, we see in the four gospels that He was preparing them for a big change.

He had to ensure that they were **locked in** to the Kingdom, and that they were **loaded** with His power.

He sent them out two by two and in groups – much like a training drill.

Then, upon return, He debriefed them. He cleared up misconceptions and warned them about boasting.

Remember, He called the twelve. They didn't choose Him.

The power they were endowed with came from Him.

It became apparent that if they simply **acted** on what He said, the necessary power and provision would be released to them.

All things were made by him, and without him was not anything made that was made – John 1:3

When God said, “let there be light,” what we know as light was in the word light.

Similarly, Jesus was in the Word that Gabriel spoke to Mary.

All she had to do was say, “Be it done unto me as you have spoken.”

With us, it is the same. **We are locked & loaded**, and ready to go!
