Bible Reading Schedule

“Two Kingdoms”

When Jesus first began training His disciples, there was an obvious lack of understanding in the **hearts and minds** of the general public.

The Kingdom of God was widely discussed and brought to the forefront by John the Baptist.

As the crowds were being baptized, they were acknowledging that they had drifted from God and needed to **repent** to get back to Him.

Even by their drifting, they were acknowledging the reality of **Two Kingdoms**.

The Apostle Paul pointed out there were two seeds – the *natural* seed of Abraham, and the *spiritual* seed of Abraham.

The Apostle John had revelation of the Jerusalem which is above, and the natural Jerusalem.

These revelations are widely discussed in the New Testament.

Jesus, before His crucifixion, called out a distinction between the world and God's people.

*They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world –
John 17:16*

That is actually what is meant by being born again. “Born from above” is an alternate translation.

*Being born again, not of corruptible seed but of incorruptible
by the Word of God, which lives and abides forever –
1 Peter 1:23*

We, as Christians, were all born of a corruptible seed, but we have been **Born Again!**
