“Reference Points”

When Moses was laying down the law, so to speak, it was evident that God wanted to eliminate ambiguity out of man's deliberations.

This was very critical because the stakes were so high.

The penalty of death by stoning was very common in the Law of Moses.

Moses had to delegate some of his authority to the seventy leaders who would answer all but the toughest cases.

Their word would become as critical as Moses' word.

Bribes were considered a major threat to true justice.

Bearing false witness was prohibited by the Ten Commandments.

A means of establishing the **truth** became a top priority.

So, **God set a standard.**

“In the mouths of two or three witnesses may every word be established.” - Deuteronomy 17:6

Establishing truth meant establishing **reference points**.

“In the mouths of two or three witnesses” became the doctrinal test used by the Apostle Paul to teach the New Testament disciples how to speak truth to your neighbors.

The arbitrary nature of man's discourse made it difficult for civilizations to develop.

Later, the same means were used to establish the scientific process, and led to what we know to be science.

God's **principal of truth** is at the base of it.
