“Take Inventory”

On two separate occasions, Jesus prayed over a small accounting of loaves and fishes that were available.

On both occasions, the small accounting was sufficient. When amplified, it was enough to feed multitudes of people.

Jesus wanted to see how their disciples would handle the event.

Their answer was, “What are so few among so many?”

The **Taking of Inventory** quickly became a circumstance in the minds of the disciples.

They were used to the Not Enough mentality.

This is also known as the “is the glass half empty, or half full” scenario.

Sometimes we see **abundance**. Sometimes we see lack.

On one occasion, Jesus wanted to know how the disciples **saw** things.

On another occasion, Jesus remarked “Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees.”

The disciples interpreted that statement with their stomachs.

Again, they were **taking inventory**, but were using the wrong measurement – Natural rather than Spiritual.

Jesus wanted the disciples to **see** God as their source.

Instead of assuming that it can't be done, let's **ask Him!**

Take inventory from God's perspective!
