*“Escape Plan”*

Often, **Escape Plans** are shown to be secretive and mysterious.

That might be necessary if there is a need to “let a sleeping dog lie,” so to speak...however...

An alternate view is as follows – When Paul and Silas were in the Philippian jail, there was nothing **secretive** or **quiet** about the way God shook the foundations of the jail, and loosed the bonds of everyone held captive.

Paul later said the local officials should come and escort Paul and Silas **publicly** away from the jail.

There's nothing **quiet** or **secretive** about that.

When God led the Israelites out of Egypt, He laid the **plans** out in advance.

Moses even went in and told Pharaoh what would happen, again and again.

When Jesus paid the **price** for us in Hell, there was nothing quiet about Jesus' victory.

*He spoiled principalities and made a show of them openly.*
