“Some Like It Hot!”

Though not intentionally, Jesus frequently provoked the scribes and Pharisees, which resulted in a **hot** environment.

The Apostle Paul had the same effect by intentionally provoking and dividing the Sadducees and Pharisees.

Paul knew their **hot** buttons – it was about resurrection.

The Sadducees were **violently opposed** to teaching a resurrection.

They were *Sad* you see.

Neither the Apostle Paul, nor Jesus, intentionally created a **hot** environment, they both had a similar reaction from their critics.

Yet, they never stopped speaking the **truth**.

And you shall know the truth, and the truth will set you free.
- John 8:32

Speaking the **truth** in love causes an eventual calm – it produces **peace**.

Having a **hot spot** in your life can draw darkness toward you.

Remember, God never stops speaking the **truth**.

Moses was commissioned to speak **truth** into Pharaoh’s life.

Pharaoh had a **hot spot** – the nation of Israel.

It took a while, but he let God’s people go.

This was a step to eventual **peace**.
