"No Vacancy"

When Jesus was teaching on casting out devils, He mentioned that demons come back to see if there is a **vacancy** to be filled.

So, our position should be that we provide **No Haven** for demons in our lives.

Our posture is "No, devil, you've been cast out. You remain homeless."

This way, our lives remain **inhospitable** to the devil and all darkness.

We must rather fill our lives with service to the Lord.

Romans 6 informs us of a number of things that we can do to **keep the devil out**.

Water Baptism should be a barrier to darkness.

It should remind us and the devil that salvation renders the death of the **old man** in our lives.

We are also told that offering our members, or ourselves, for His service will **convert** our members (bodies) to a **New Lifestyle**.

Church Attendance becomes one of those services.

Congregational singing should also be a barrier to the devil.

When we make church attendance our prerogative, we are telling the devil we are **open to being overthrown**.

"Forsake not the assembling of yourselves together" is not optional!
